

BMS Week of Respect Activities - 10/5/15 - 10/9/15

Monday - 10/5/15 - Students will wear blue for National Anti-Bullying Day. Also, during morning announcements that morning the song "RESPECT" by Aretha Franklin will play over the intercom while students drop everything to dance and sing in order to kick off our "Week of RESPECT".

Tuesday - 10/6/15 - PTA sponsored FUN DAY

Wednesday - 10/7/15 - "Arms Around BMS" Students and staff will circle the outside blacktop area and recite the Anti-bullying Pledge as a whole group.

Thursday - 10/8/15 - " Day of Tolerance" Students will be scheduled into the cafeteria for an approx. 40 minute lesson in the morning. A story will be read to students on Tolerance/Respect. Kindergarten will be paired with fifth grade, First grade will be paired with Fourth grade, and Second grade will be paired with Third grade to work on a RESPECT project with their partners. Three "Rays of Respect" suns will be created from the three different groups. One representing Respect of Self, one representing Respect of Others, and one representing Respect of Community.

Friday - 10/9/15 - Students will wear yellow for the Character Education Theme of RESPECT - students are asked to remember the "Golden Rule" of treat others as you would like to be treated.. Character Education Lessons Begin Teachers will begin the lesson by playing the Life Vest Boomerang video (<http://www.lifevestinside.com/projects/film/>) in grades k-5 and have a class discussion.
