

5514 PUPIL USE OF VEHICLES

For reasons of health and safety, students are prohibited from riding bicycles, scooters, skateboards, in-line skates and all other non-motorized or motorized vehicles on school property while school is in session or when students are arriving or leaving for the school day.

However, riding such vehicles by pupils on school property during the school day may be permitted only when part of an authorized school activity or in conjunction with a component of the approved instructional program, and such use is under the direct supervision of a member of the instructional staff of the school district. It is the responsibility of the supervising staff member to limit the use of any non-motorized or motorized vehicle to students whose level of riding skill and knowledge of riding safety are commensurate with the requirements of the activity.

In any event, all laws and regulations regarding the wearing of helmets and other protective gear shall apply to all those riding these vehicles on school property at all times.
