

0146.1 INDIVIDUAL BOARD MEMBER VISITATIONS

The Board of Education recognizes that it exists as a legal entity as defined in New Jersey Statutes, and its actions as a quasi-municipal authority of the State are defined by the statutes, as are the responsibilities and actions of the officers and members of the Board.

In an effort to remain informed about the methods and procedures utilized in the administration and operations of the schools in this district, the Board shall authorize visitations to individual schools by individual members of the Board subject to the following procedures:

1. Individual Board members desiring to visit a school shall contact the Superintendent of Schools, and arrange for such visit on a date and time as shall be convenient for the Principal of the school as well as the individual Board member.
2. The Superintendent shall arrange with the Building Principal of the school to be visited a date and time which is mutually convenient for the Principal and visiting Board member.
3. Upon confirmation of the mutually agreed upon date and time of the visitation, it is the obligation of the Board member to present himself to the Principal's office at the time of the visitation, in order for the Principal to properly show the individual Board member such things as may be requested.
4. Nothing in the previous paragraphs shall be construed as to withdraw from individual Board members such other visitation privileges which they may have as parents in any of the individual district schools, with the same restrictions on visitations placed administratively on all parents or other visitors in such schools.
